Guest Speaker



We are delighted to welcome Dr. Anthony Romeo to Dublin as our inaugural speaker and guest of honour at I.S.E.S. 2017.

Dr. Romeo is an orthopaedic shoulder and sports medicine surgeon at Midwest Orthopaedics at Rush and professor in the Department of Orthopedics at Rush University Medical Center. He is also a team physician for the Chicago White Sox and the Chicago Bulls.

Dr. Romeo received his Medical Degree from the St. Louis University School of Medicine. He completed his residency in orthopaedic surgery at the Cleveland Clinic Foundation in Ohio, and his shoulder and elbow surgery fellowship at the University of Washington Medical Center in Seattle with Dr. Matsen. Furthermore, while completing his undergraduate Bachelor of Science at the University of Notre Dame, he was a member of the University of Notre Dame football team, the "Fighting Irish".

Throughout his esteemed career, Dr. Romeo has received numerous honours and awards for his outstanding accomplishments in innovative research that enhances patient care. He has been recognized as one of the Best Doctors in America and one of the Top Doctors in Chicago for multiple years. Dr. Romeo is one of fewer than 6% of physicians selected to receive the Patient's Choice Award. His honours for excellence in research include the Best Scientific Exhibit at the 2010 American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons, the Western Orthopaedic Association's Lloyd Taylor Award, Best Poster at Rush University Sigma Xi day, multiple research grants from the Arthroscopy Association of North America and the Orthopaedic Research and Education Foundation (OREF), Award Paper from the Illinois OREF Research Competition, the Winning Paper and the Excellence in Research Award from the Rush University Annual Thesis Day, the ISAKOS Science Award for Best Overall Paper, the Emanuel B. Kaplan Award, and many others. He has authored numerous peer-reviewed papers, as well as book chapters, and has served as senior editor of a number of orthopaedic and sports medicine text books. Dr. Romeo is a designer of shoulder arthroplasty systems and lectures all over the world on advanced shoulder and elbow surgery. He is the current President-Elect of the prestigious American Shoulder and Elbow Society, and will lead that society as 2017-2018 President. We are very fortunate to have him here in Dublin for our society's launch and we sincerely hope that he enjoys his visit to Ireland.

Mr James Colville graduated in Medicine from Trinity College, Dublin. His orthopaedic training was on the Irish national training programme. Following on from this, he completed upper limb fellowships in Heinola, Finland and St Galen, Switzerland. He was awarded a Shoulder Reconstruction Scholarship in Columbia

Medical Centre in New York. During his distinguished career he held the following positions: President of the British Elbow/Shoulder Society, President of the Irish Society for Surgery of the Hand, President Irish Association of Occupational Therapists, Vice Dean of the Faculty of Sports & Exercise Medicine. For many years, he co-chaired the annual Dublin Sports Surgery course. His main area of specialization has been the management of the sports injured shoulder and throughout his career, he carried out in excess of 1500 surgical procedures to treat shoulder instability.

We are extremely grateful to John Lynch, Pamela Davis and all the team at Lynch Medical for their assistance with the Inaugural Irish Shoulder and Elbow Society Meeting. 


About ISES





The organising committe would like to thank the Irish Institute of Trauma and Orthopaedic Surgery for their support and to the Royal College of Surgeons for the use of their facilities.


